Since this was the first time any kind of cryptocurrency-related event was being held at NED University, there was immense responsibility on the society to try pulling off the event in the best way possible so as to create a benchmark for the upcoming batches. Various field-related speakers were invited to come and share their knowledge & experience from the world of cryptocurrency & block chain. In addition to that, a theatre-play was also made part of this event to give a little touch of entertainment & action to this seminar.

The event was kick-started by the recitation of verses from the Holy Quran which was also translated to convey a better understanding of the verses. After the recitation, the event was formally initiated when the hosts called upon the Speaker of the Day, Mr. Muhammad Ahsan Khan. A block chain evangelist, Mr. Ahsan talked about the ins and outs of the cryptocurrency. He also highlighted his projects that are currently up and running. A very comprehensive explanation was provided for many types of major and minor confusions & myths about cryptocurrency and processes related to it.

Banking procedures and methods adopted by various companies were also discussed by him.
